 - Presentation @ NIST (National Institute for Standards and Technology) /NICE (National Initiative for Cyber Security Education) 2016 to have 2017 event in Dayton
 - Dayton was awarded the NIST/NICE 2017 Event on November 7-8; Planning is just starting
 - SOCHI (Southwestern Ohio Council for Higher Education) Brief; Sean Creighton
 - Creating the Cincinnati-Dayton Cyber Corridor (Cin-Day Cyber)
 - A regional consortia approach to cyber security education and workforce readiness.
 - Cin-Day Cyber Proposal was one of five proposals awarded nationally from a pool of 65 proposals across 34 states
 - U.S. Department of Commerce
